1. There is NO entry fee
2. All entry forms must be submitted to the Social Services Department no later than September 9, 2016 by 5pm. Any entry forms received after the deadline date, will be placed at the end of the parade and will not be guaranteed announcement during parade.
3. Registration and line-up will begin at 8:30 am on Saturday, September 17th in front of the Seminole Nation ASAP building.
4. All entries and participants must enter at the intersection of Strother Street and Main Street. Traffic will only be allowed to flow in one direction, from North to South. If assistance is needed, a parade volunteer will be on hand to help transport passengers to entries.
5. Absolutely no candy or other items will be thrown from any vehicle, float, etc. You may walk alongside the vehicles to hand out items. Please understand that distribution of candy or promotional items while walking along the curb is acceptable, but tossing items from the parade is strictly prohibited. You understand that you will be held responsible for any accident occurring as a result of throwing anything to the crowd which would result in a person running into the street to retrieve the thrown object during the parade.
6. Please bag horses. Un-bagged horses will be placed at the end of the parade.
7. Entries will be judged on:
 - Representation of Seminole Culture
 - Originality
 - Overall Visual Appeal

All entry forms must be submitted no later than September 9th at 5pm.
